- The central aim of this CCM Engagement Strategy is to synchronize national and regional approaches to MSM, TG and HIV related interventions in South Asia in order to avoid duplication in relation to goals, objectives and activities,
- An important goal is to complement the work of national CCMs, to work within and supportive of national responses across South Asia,
- Facilitate supportive and engaged involvement of national CCMs in the South Asia MSM, TG and HIV related Program.

CCM Engagement Opportunities

- Attendance in and participation at national CCM meetings by key sub-contract recipients – CCM meetings represent important forums for ensuring timely and appropriate communication between the South Asia MSM, TG and HIV related Program and national CCM contacts.
- Attendance at and participation in twice-yearly Stakeholder Workshops in the South Asia region – Regional Stakeholder Workshops will play an important role in sharing best practice, information, status of activities and key successes and results.



CCM Engagement Opportunities



- Regular reporting to and discussion with Chairs of national CCMs on both national-specific and regional activities – Vice Chairpersons of CCMs have been identified as policy-level focal points for communication between the South Asia MSM, TG and HIV-related Program and national CCMs.
- Communicating results and the status of activities – communication of results and the status of activities to CCMs is an important strategy for avoiding duplication and ensuring that the South Asia MSM, TG and HIV-related Program is working within and complementary to national HIV responses.





CCM Engagement Opportunities

- Providing capacity building of MSM, TG and HIV related CBOs is a central objective of the South Asia MSM, TG and HIV related.
- The CCM-appointed Sexual Minorities Focal Points have been identified as the key focal points for contact and coordination between national CCMs and the South Asia MSM and TG Program – some CCMs have appointed a Sexual Minorities Focal Point to act as communication point (along with Vice Chairpersons of CCMS).
